Educational Scholarships

To encourage associates and associates' children of Nordic Group Member Companies to become well-educated individuals and to develop marketable, self-supporting skills by awarding annual scholarships to students who are children of the Nordic Group Member Companies associates.

Two College Scholarships

\$3,000 annually, renewable for up to four years, if the student remains eligible.

One Music & Performing Arts Scholarship

\$3,000 annually, renewable for up to four years, if the student remains eligible.

Two Technical School Scholarships

\$500 per semester, renewable for up to four consecutive semesters, if the student remains eligible.

Hillsdale College Scholarship

\$5,000 per year, renewable for up to four years, if the student remains eligible.

**Four Public Education (High School) Scholarships
Saltillo, Mexico**

Currently offered for two children of Seats Mexico associates and two children of Plásticos Flambeau associates in Saltillo, Mexico. Scholarships are for full coverage of all annual expenses (approximately \$1,000 USD per student) and is renewable for two to three years depending on the particular track a student is on according to the structure of the Mexican Education System.
